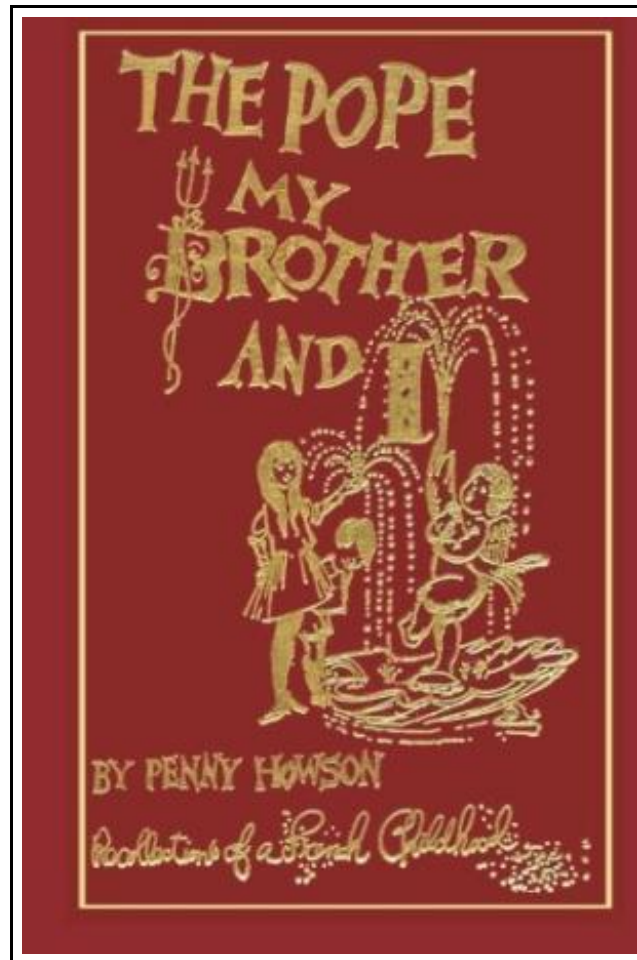

Her father is preoccupied only with the fluctuations of Anaconda copper stock and the dreadful effect of the new Metro line on his wine cellar. Her grandmother, Boma, concentrates on knitting and on the tribulations of her weekly day of dieting. Her mother's response is pleasantly vague; her sixteen-year-old sister, Tozy, is more direct: Who asked you, little fat one! This leaves only her five-year old brother, Jean-Paul. And he, more than any of the others, requires her attention - for Jean-Paul has not been baptized! With her goal now clearly in mind, Regine is relentless. In the face of her family's massive indifference, she determines to baptize Jean-Paul herself, and the rollicking pursuit of her brother's salvation that follows is a masterpiece of wry and affectionate humor. In her loving characterizations of her family, in her deft use of comedy and in her representation of a French way of life that has almost disappeared today, Penny Howson has created a gem of a book. The Pope, My Brother and I is funny, heart-warming and poignant in the finest tradition of childhood recollections.
